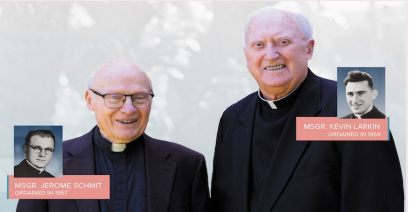
This series will help us to better understand and carry out Christ's mandate to care for the sick and dying in a manner that honors God and respects the dignity of persons.
