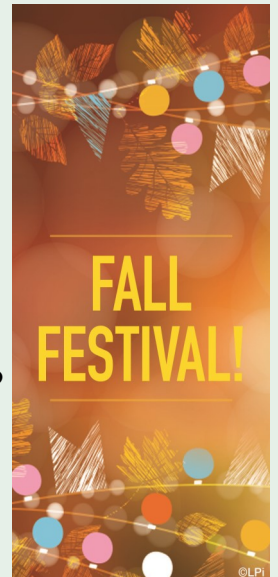

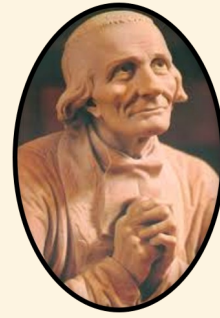
The celebration will be held at the Cathedral of SS Peter and Paul and will include:
