"I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture." (John 10:9)

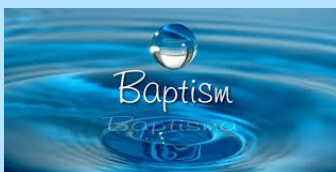

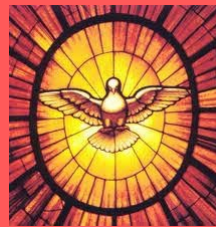
