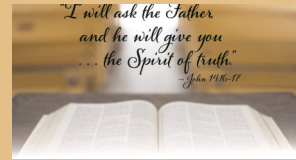

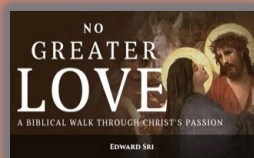


TECHNOLOGY MINISTRY
