This class is in preparation for all parents whose children are being baptized on July 9th.

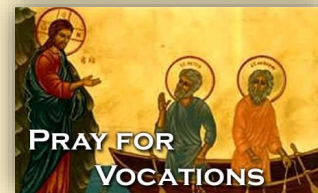
