

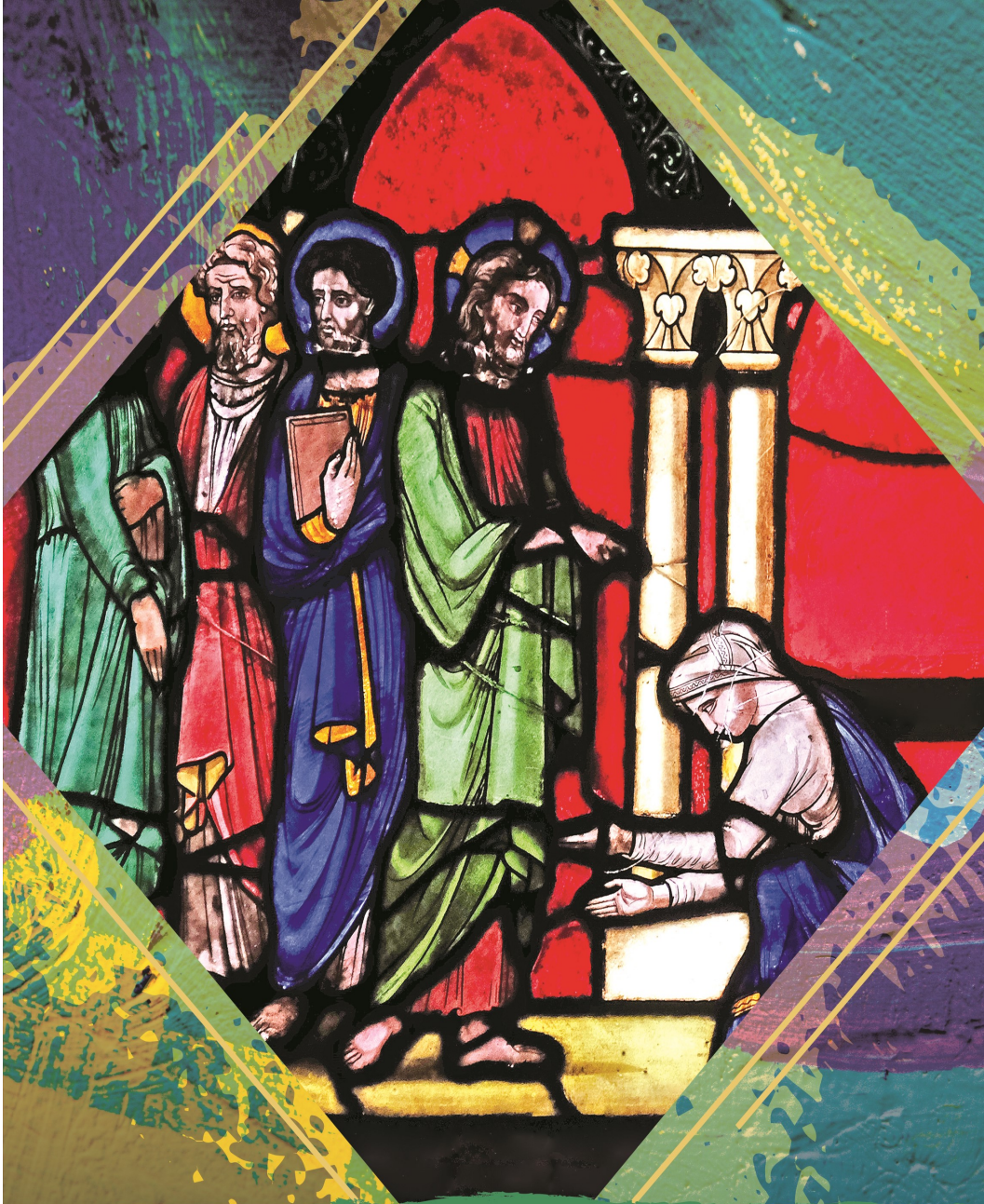

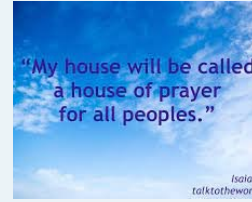

FAITH FORMATION SCHEDULE:

Faith Formation classes will begin the first weekend of October. Families who have registered will receive a full lesson calendar, teacher assignments, and other details in September.

Grade 1: Children participate in a home program one on one with their parents.

Grade 2: Sunday mornings at 8:30am

Grade 3: Sunday mornings at 9:45am

Grade 4: Monday afternoons at 5:00pm

Grade 5: Monday afternoons at 6:15pm

Grade 6 & 7: Tuesday evenings in alternating weeks

Grade 8 & 9: Sunday evenings in alternating weeks

Children attending Catholic schools must enroll in our program for sacramental years (grades 2, 3, 8, and 9).

Please Note: Effective 2021, those public school students who have missed more than 2 years of faith formation after receiving the Sacrament of First Holy Communion, will be required to attend 3 years of preparation for Confirmation (7, 8 & 9 grades).

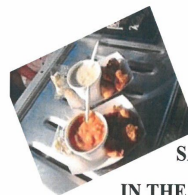
